We got through! Finally, and with great gratitude to God, we have been able to speak directly with William Bertrand, our EFC-ER missionary in Haiti. He confirms that his wife, Marie, and he are safe and healthy. Praise God!

He met with our EFC-Haiti pastors two days after the earthquake for prayer and coordination of effort during this needy time. Our churches are continuing to gather for worship and they are reaching out to serve, bringing hope and comfort to hundreds of people.

Thankfully, William and Marie are able to oversee the distribution of safe drinking water from our deep well in Osten, where the Bertrands live. (EFC-ER work teams have made this well and generator possible just in the past two years!)

EFC-ER also continues to partner closely with World Relief.

Thanks so very much for praying, giving and reaching out to demonstrate the love of Jesus to our Haitian friends who are in such desperate need.
